**Sanders Moore Jr update**

Sanders Moore Jr (3/27/60) is being held on \$38,000 bail on charges of burglary and receiving & concealing stolen property. Moore, who has been in custody since July 1, is set to make his next court appearance on January 14.

**October 30** At 1:25 a.m., police arrested 21-year-old Jacob Joseph Gertz of St Louis Park for felony possession of burglary tools at an address on the 4900 block of Upton.

**October 31** Between 2:00 and 9:15 p.m., unknown suspect(s) broke the front door of a home on the 4900 block of Morgan in Lynnhurst, gained entry, and took unlisted items.

**November 2** Between November 2 and 6, an unknown suspect stole a vehicle which was parked on the street at 44<sup>th</sup> & Lake Harriet Parkway in Linden Hills.

**November 3** At about 8 p.m., police responded to a report of an assault with a weapon at Café Maud, 5411 Penn Ave in Armatage. The caller provided police with the license plate number of the suspect's vehicle. Police located the suspect at his residence on the 4800 block of Penn. After an investigation, 48-year-old James Christopher Sergeant of 4835 Penn Ave South was arrested for felony terroristic threats.

**November 3** Between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m., an unknown suspect stole a vehicle which was parked on the street on the 4600 block of Zenith in Linden Hills.

**November 3** Between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m., an unknown suspect broke a lock and opened a basement window of a home on the 5900 block of Upton in Armatage. There was no sign of entry.

**November 4** At about 3:50 p.m., a suspect approached a ten-year-old boy at 44<sup>th</sup> & Abbott in Linden Hills and tried to lure him into his vehicle. The victim refused and the suspect left the area.

**November 8** Between 1 p.m. on November 8 and 11:30 a.m. November 15, an unknown suspect cut the screen of the back door of a home on the 5300 block of James in Lynnhurst, gained entry to the house, and stole a TV and DVD player from the basement. The reporting person told police that she and her ex-boyfriend were leasing the home, that they had recently split up, and that the ex-boyfriend was in jail. The person stated that she received a phone message from the ex-boyfriend's cousin requesting that she meet him at the address to let him "get the smoke out." There was no sign of forced entry to the dwelling, which made it appear that a spare key may have been used. The person stated that the stolen property was mutually owned by her and the ex-boyfriend. The person stated that two handguns found in the basement were turned over to police at an earlier date, and that she felt that whoever entered the home was possibly looking for guns and drugs.

**November 10** At about 11:30 p.m., squads were dispatched to a report of a loud party at an address on the 5700 block of Morgan in Armatage. Police arrested 40-year-old Karl Frederick Jenne III of 5732 Morgan Ave South for disruptive party and obstructing the legal process.
