Sanders Moore Jr update

Sanders Moore Jr (3/27/60), who has been in custody since July 1, made a court appearance on February 4 on charges of burglary and receiving & concealing stolen property. According to the County Attorney's office, Moore was found incompetent to proceed – which means that he is not able to understand the proceedings or assist in his own defense due to mental illness – and a petition for commitment was filed. Moore's criminal cases have been continued to August 8 and he is being held without bail pending a February 14 appearance in Mental Health court to make a decision about the petition for commitment.

Crime reports – Fulton, Linden Hills, Armatage, Kenny, Lynnhurst

January 8 At about 5:45 p.m., a person returning home to an address on the 4400 block of Beard in Linden Hills saw three suspects who had gained entry to the garage. The suspects fled from the area.

January 8 Between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the door of a garage on the 5900 block of Dupont in Kenny. No items were taken and it does not appear that the suspect went through the vehicles which were parked inside. The suspect left the garage light on.

January 8 Between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the service door of a garage on the 5800 block of Morgan in Armatage and rummaged through an unlocked vehicle which was parked inside.

January 8 Between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m., an unknown suspect entered an unlocked garage on the 6000 block of Emerson in Kenny, broke a window of a locked vehicle which was parked inside, and took a video game dock. Another vehicle parked inside was ransacked, and the suspect took a battery charger from the garage.

January 8 Between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the service door of a garage on the 5700 block of Newton in Armatage and took a car stereo and CDs from an unlocked vehicle which was parked inside.

January 9 Between 1 and 8 a.m., an unknown suspect kicked in the service door of a garage on the 5800 block of Colfax in Kenny. The suspect broke a window of a locked truck which was parked inside and pryed the stereo from the dashboard. Another vehicle parked inside was ransacked, but nothing was taken.

January 18 Between 9 p.m. January 18 and 1 p.m. January 21, an unknown suspect stole a truck with a snowplow and a cement mixer which was parked on the street on the 5000 block of Washburn Ave.

January 26 At about 1:05 a.m., officers observed a young male walking northbound on Xerxes Ave at 49th St. The suspect told officers that he was 18 years old, but an i.d. check revealed that he was only 16. Officers cited the suspect for curfew violation, transported him home, and released him to his grandmother.

January 26 At about 10:30 a.m., officers responded to a suspicious vehicle call at 51st & Aldrich in Lynnhurst. The caller stated that the suspects were possibly waiting to buy drugs. Officers located the vehicle and found suspected narcotics inside. 21-year-old Nathan Lloyd Hagemo of Edina and 39-year-old Frederick Timothy Smith of St Paul were arrested for felony narcotics violations. The vehicle was impounded.

January 27 At about 11:15 p.m., three suspects were cited for fleeing police on foot at 43rd & Upton in Linden Hills: 23-year-old Gilbert Benjamin Schwartz of 1903 South 6th St, 18-year-old William Alexander Schwartz of 2606 Garfield Ave, and 25-year-old Nathaniel David Secor of 2301 23rd Ave South.

January 29 Between 9:15 and 9:20 p.m., a suspect burglarized a garage on the 3900 block of Ewing in Linden Hills. Numerous items were stolen.

January 29 At about 9:40 p.m., a suspect burglarized a garage on the 3800 block of Drew in Linden Hills. The victim confronted the suspect, who fled.

January 30 At about 7:15 a.m., a suspect stole a car which was running and unlocked in the driveway of a residence on the 5800 block of Upton in Armatage. At 7:50 a.m., a 3rd Precinct squad saw the vehicle, which crashed. The suspect fled on foot and was not apprehended.

January 31 At about 2 a.m., officers responded to a call regarding an unwanted person in an apartment at 5031 France Ave South. Prior to arrival, officers identified the caller and found that he had an active misdemeanor warrant for theft of services. Officers arrived and learned that the unwanted person was a male who had been invited over by the caller's girlfriend, who also lived at that address. Officers arrested 44-year-old Timothy Paul Ruddy for the misdemeanor warrant.

January 30 At 8 p.m., police recovered a stolen vehicle from an address on the 6000 block of Xerxes in Armatage.

January 31 At about 3 a.m., police responded to a possible personal injury accident at 52nd & Xerxes; a caller reported that a vehicle was in a snowbank and two people were arguing. The driver of the vehicle then called 911 and stated that she needed assistance from the police. Officers determined that the driver was under the influence of alcohol and placed her under arrest for DWI. After a chem test was administered, the suspect spit on an officer. 21-year-old Nicole Marie Krumholz of 5136 Abbott Ave South was arrested for DWI, driving with a revoked license, possession of drug paraphernalia, a petty misdemeanor narcotics violation, and 4th degree assault of a police officer.
