

Fulton Safety Committee report: April, 2008

Crime reports – Fulton, Linden Hills, Armatage, Kenny, Lynnhurst

March 12 Between 12:30 and 6:30 p.m., an unknown suspect forced entry to a home on the 4800 block of Queen via the front door and took unlisted items. The door and door frame were damaged.

March 14 At about 6:20 p.m., officers were dispatched to an address on the 4300 block of Ewing in Linden Hills on a report of a person with a gun.

March 15 Between 5 p.m. March 15 and noon March 16, an unknown suspect burglarized Bone Adventure, 5045 France Ave, and took unlisted items.

March 24 A resident reported that, between 7:45 a.m. and 9:30 p.m., an apartment on the 5800 block of Washburn in Armatage was burglarized.

March 28 At about 10:20 p.m., officers responded to a disturbance call on the 3500 block of West 48th St where a possible weapon was seen. Officers cleared the call and then responded to the closed park nearby where a group was being loud. Officers recognized a vehicle parked near 49th & Chowen with which they had contact regarding drug use a couple of weeks previously. The driver was the same, a 17-year-old male who attempted to hide items. The vehicle smelled strongly of freshly burnt marijuana, and the driver and passenger, 18-year-old Marquis Anthony Moy of 5020 Drew Ave South, both showed signs of marijuana use, i.e., bloodshot and watery eyes. Drug paraphernalia was found outside the passenger's door and on the floor by the passenger's seat. A pack of cigarettes and lighters were found inside the center console. The juvenile driver was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia and status offenses and was transported home. Moy was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia and released at the scene. The vehicle was impounded since both suspects were under the influence of marijuana, making it illegal for them to drive.

March 25 Between 9:45 p.m. and 6 a.m., an unknown suspect stole a vehicle which was parked on the street on the 4100 block of Abbott in Linden Hills.

March 26 Between 10 p.m. and midnight, an unknown suspect entered an open garage on the 4200 block of Chowen in Linden Hills, entered an unlocked vehicle which was parked inside, and stole a pair of prescription glasses in a case.

March 29 Between noon March 29 and 7:30 a.m. March 31, an unknown suspect pried open the back door of a home on the 5000 block of York and took unlisted items from two main floor bedrooms. Other valuables in the home were left untouched.

April 4 Between 5:30 and 10:30 p.m., an unknown suspect forced entry to a home on the 5200 block of Drew through a basement window. No loss was initially reported.
